3) Quarry Manager's Report.

Gore, Dan Went through Gore as Lewis was unable to attend, Dan Explained that the Gore had finished stripping on the top faces, Also Dan explained that Gore was resurfacing in the quarry over the weekend of the 18th and 19th of November.

Dan explained to the meeting that the stripping that was going on at Dolyhir would be finished in the next two weeks and that stripping would start again in 2019 towards the Stones farm. Dan also explained to the meeting that Tarmac was going through a structure change but there was not much detail he could give to the meeting at this point. Dan also explained that there are resurfacing works outside of the quarry and from the berry turn on the weekend of the 24th and 25th of November.
