MIN 37/19 MINUTES OF THE MEETINGS HELD 16th JULY 2019

Resolved that the Minutes (as previously circulated) represented a true record of events. The Chairman then duly signed the Minutes.

MIN 38/19 GENERAL ITEMS

(1) Miscellaneous Matters:

- Welsh Water Barriers: Cllr. Ruth Jones reported that these had been left on site and the Clerk was asked to request their removal.
- First Aid Training: The Clerk confirmed that subject to final confirmation this was to take place on 16th September.
- Grass Cutting, Walton: Cllr. E. Jones reported that the July cut had been very poor and that cutting was actually taking place during the Royal Welsh Show. He felt that a June cut would be more beneficial and the Clerk was asked to obtain more information on the timing of cuts etc. Cllr. Powell also raised concerns about the quality of the cutting around Evenjobb.
- Further white lining work: Cllr. Morgan reported that the white lining in this area also needed refreshing.
- Old Radnor Signage: Cllr. Griffiths confirmed that the final signs were now in place.

(2) Traffic Issues Yardo: Report on Site Meeting: Cllr. M. Jones reported that following the site meeting the Traffic Engineer had informed him that it would not be possible to alter the priorities at the junction but that additional signage would be provided and the white lining on the road would be renewed. The Officer would provide him with more details in the near future.

(3) Police and Crime Commissioner's Annual Report and Newsletter: Noted.

Cllr. E. Jones left the room for the duration of the following item.

(4) Proposed New Footpath around Gore Quarry: Members discussed this at length and it was agreed to defer the matter to the September meeting. Cllr. Bell would in the meantime discuss concerns over the steep access point, why a length of existing footpath was being closed and ongoing maintenance with the County Footpaths Officer, Jill Exton.

Cllr. E. Jones returned to the room.

(5) Update re surplus Defibrillator Monies from Tarmac and possible use: Agreed that an allocated reserve for future defib costs should be set up with the £100 surplus from the purchase of the defibrillator and cabinet. The Clerk would confirm this to the Quarry.

(6) Diamond Wedding Anniversary: Members congratulated Cllr. M. Jones and his wife on their recent anniversary.

Cllr. M. Jones left the meeting at this point due to his position on the County Council Planning Committee.
