MIN 51/19 MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD 17TH SEPTEMBER 2019

Resolved that the Minutes (as previously circulated) represented a true record of events. The Chairman then duly signed the Minutes.

MIN 52/19 UPDATE ON OUTSTANDING MATTERS

(1) Grass Cutting Arrangements: The Clerk confirmed that she had emailed the County Council on adjusting the present schedule but as yet no reply had been received.

MIN 53/19 FINANCE

(1) Payments: To approve the following payments –

(2) Review of Appointment of Internal Auditor and internal audit procedures: Members approved the appointment of Mr. M. Lloyd as internal auditor for 2019-20 and agreed the terms of reference for the audit as per the draft papers previously circulated.

(3) Donation to St. John's Ambulance to thank the Group for the First Aid Training: Members agreed a donation of £25.

(4) Letters of thanks: The letters of thanks from Kinnerton PCC and Old Radnor PCC and the telephone call of thanks from Evancoyd PCC were noted.

MIN 54/19 CORRESPONDENCE/GENERAL ITEMS

(1) Adoption of Telephone Kiosk Evenjobb: Cllr. Powell reported that following the refurbishment by British Telecom and the clearing of adjacent vegetation by volunteers there was no immediate need for adoption and he asked that the matter be removed from the agenda for the time being. Should it need to be re-visited he would ask the Clerk to include an agenda item.

(2) First Aid in Old Radnor Community: Cllr. Bell had nothing further to report. It was agreed to review training needs annually unless sufficient numbers were held on a waiting list.

(3) Footpaths Update: Cllr. Bell reported on recent matters and stated that he was very pleased with the relationship with both footpath officers.

(4) Temporary Footpath Closure – Old Radnor: Noted.

(5) Resident Letter re give way sign and condition of road, Dolyhir Quarry: Members noted the letter raising concerns about the condition of the road at the entrance to the Dolyhir Quarry and also at the fading of the give way on the road at the foot of the Old Radnor hill (Dolyhir Quarry End). They shared the concerns at the failure to re-surface the section of road mentioned particularly as this was something that had been raised by the Community Council on several previous occasions. The Clerk was asked to write to the County Council on both these issues requesting urgent action and Members were encouraged to also report the issues personally via the County Council website.

(6) Items for Quarry Liaison Meeting: Council representatives were asked to raise the need to cut back overhanging boughs on the Yardro road as these were now so low that lorries were needing to use the verge. Members heard that the trees at Sunnybank were to be trimmed at the end of the week. The Clerk was asked to chase the Quarry for a formal agenda

Cllr. M. Jones left the meeting at this point due to his position on the County Council Planning Committee.
