### **MIN 39/20 FINANCE**

(1) Local Government Pay Award: Members noted the local government pay award for 2020 and that the Clerk's pay will increase accordingly as the relevant pay point has increased. An allowance of 3% for an increase had been made in the 2020-21 budget.
