MIN 44/16 INFORMATION FROM MINUTES

MIN 47/16 CORRESPONDENCE

(1) Public Rights of Way in the Old Radnor Community Council Area Update: Cllr. Bell provided a brief update on paths in the Quarry area. He also agreed to draft a letter to the County Council Footpath Enforcement Officer on a particular issue for consideration at the September Meeting.

(2) Quarry Liaison Committee: Report on Meeting: Cllr. Morgan had attended. The Quarry would issue Minutes in due course.

(3) Defibrillators: The Clerk reported that both Evenjobb and Walton Village Halls were in principle in agreement for units to be sited on the outside of their buildings. In addition BT had confirmed the kiosk in Old Radnor was available for adoption. Just two calls had been made in the last twelve months. If adopted BT would supply a paint kit to refurbish the kiosk and continue to provide an electricity supply initially. Kinnerton Village Hall would be meeting in early September to discuss the siting of a unit in the village. The Clerk asked that Members give consideration to the number and location of units to be included in a grant application bearing in mind the limit of £5000. Match funding would be looked on favourably as part of the application. Further discussion to take place at the September meeting.
